CHALLENGES

- **Declining volunteerism** across the non-profit sector required extra effort to recruit and support volunteers while maintaining care standards.
- **Closed North Haven** to streamline services under one roof and improve long-term efficiency.
- Due to challenges in the current building, **ongoing disease outbreaks** increased medical costs and quarantine periods, extending the stay of some animals.
